That the City Manager of The City of San Diego is hereby authorized, for and on behalf of said City, to submit a grant application for law enforcement purposes to CCCJ pursuant to the terms and conditions set forth in the form of grant application on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 751610, and is further authorized to execute, for and on behalf of said City, a grant award contract for law enforcement purposes including any extensions or amendments thereof and any subgrants pursuant thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the applicant agrees to provide matching funds as may be required for said project (including any extension or amendment thereof) under the Safe Streets Act and the rules and regulations of CCCJ and the Law Enforcement Assistance Administration.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant on-going law enforcement expenditures.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council finds this activity is exempt as per CITY OF SAN DIEGO GUIDELINES, as amended in February, 1974, IMPLEMENTING THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT OF 1970, with reference to the "EXISTING FACILITIES" exemption contained in Section V, Part A, Class 1.
