

RESOLUTION NO. 213675

WHEREAS, the Council finds that nutritional needs are the highest priority needs for senior citizens within the City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, adequate nutrition is necessary for the preservation of the physical, mental and emotional health of senior citizens; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to continue the existing Senior Citizen Nutrition Program currently operated in North Park, Linda Vista and Pacific Beach under contract with the San Diego Unified School District; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has presented a report by memorandum to the Council dated June 17, 1975, entitled "Senior Citizen Expanded Nutrition Program" which contains numerous recommendations for expanding and changing said program; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the City Manager be, and he is hereby authorized to execute, for and on behalf of said City, an agreement with the SAN DIEGO UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT which will continue said existing on-site nutritional program in said areas at Florence Elementary School, Crown Point Elementary School and Montgomery Junior High School, pursuant to the terms and conditions set forth in the form of agreement on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 751904, and said expenses shall be drawn from the



\$350,000 set aside for this purpose through General Revenue Sharing Funds budgeted for fiscal year 1976 in the Human Resources Department Budget as authorized in Resolution No. 213301. Said contract shall be for the period of July 1, 1975, through September 30, 1975, and shall allow the expenditure of not more than \$34,320 from said General Revenue Sharing Funds for said time period.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that said City Manager's recommendations for additional sites and program expansion as contained in said "Senior Citizen Expanded Nutrition Program" report shall be immediately referred back to the Public Services and Safety Committee for further study, evaluation, and recommendations.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Council action taken on June 19, 1975, on this subject in Resolution No. 213612 be repealed and be superseded by this resolution.
