RESOLUTION REQUESTING AN ALLOCATION OF STATE PARTICIPATING FUNDS FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF A GRADE SEPARATION ON HARBOR DRIVE AT ATCHISON, TOPEKA AND SANTA FE RAILWAY COMPANY TRACT AND DECLARING THAT NECESSARY CITY MATCHING FUNDS ARE AVAILABLE.

WHEREAS, The City of San Diego has proposed the construction of a wider grade separation on Harbor Drive at The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway track; and

WHEREAS, it is required that the City furnish evidence to the California Department of Transportation that sufficient funds are available for the City's portion of the proposed work before an allocation of State funds is made; and

WHEREAS, said City certifies that all requirements of Section 190 of the Streets and Highways Code have been met, that Public Utilities Commission orders have been issued, necessary railroad agreements have been executed, sufficient local agency funds are available to finance one-half of the estimated cost of the project after first deducting the railroad contribution, and all other matters prerequisite to awarding the construction contract within six months have been or can be taken care of within that time; and

WHEREAS, the cost of the grade separation is estimated as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. The State Department of Transportation be requested to allocate \$1,562,400 in State funds under the provisions of Section 190 of the California Streets and Highways Code for the construction of the aforementioned grade separation in accordance with the aforesaid provisions and detailed information being submitted to the California Highway Commission by the City through the State Division of Highways.

2. Funds are reserved for construction of the aforementioned grade separation under CIP No. 52-203(76) and scheduled for fiscal year 1975-76 in the Streets and Highways Section of the City of San Diego Capital Improvements Program adopted by Ordinance No. 11650 N.S. and are sufficient to cover the City's portion of the proposed work.
