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WHEREAS, The City of San Diego desires to undertake a certain project designated Women's Detoxification Services, to be funded in part from funds made available through the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968, PL 90-351, as amended, PL 91-644 (hereafter referred to as the Safe Streets Act), administered by the California Council on Criminal Justice (hereafter referred to as CCCJ); NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the applicant agrees to provide matching funds as may be required for said project (including any extension or amendment thereof) under the Safe Streets Act and the rules and regulations of CCCJ and the Law Enforcement Assistance Administration.

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant on-going law enforcement expenditures.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council finds this activity is exempt as per CITY OF SAN DIEGO GUIDELINES, as amended in February, 1974, IMPLEMENTING THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT OF 1970, with reference to the "EXISTING FACILITIES" exemption contained in Section V, Part A, Class 1.
