RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, AWARDING THE AGGREGATE AMOUNT OF THIRTEEN MILLION FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$13,500,000) IN TAX ANTICIPATION NOTES TO THE BEST BIDDER AND REJECTING ALL OTHER BIDS, AND AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 213736 AS IT RELATES TO DATE OF SAID NOTES.

WHEREAS, at the time and place fixed for the opening of bids for the purchase of the aggregate amount of Thirteen Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$13,500,000) Tax Anticipation Notes of The City of San Diego, California, pursuant to notice inviting the bids, all bids were publicly opened, examined and read, and tabulation thereof has been entered in the minutes; and

WHEREAS, the bid of the bidder hereinafter named is the best bid made by a responsible bidder for the Notes; NOW, THEREFORE,

The City Council of The City of San Diego does hereby RESOLVE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

The bid of UNITED CALIFORNIA BANK

offering 100.0	_% of par and a net interest cost of
\$ 453,960	is hereby accepted and the Notes are hereby
awarded to the bes	st bidder in accordance with the notice inviting
bids and Resolution	on No. 213736.

- 2. All bids other than the one accepted herein are rejected and the checks accompanying them shall be returned to the respective unsuccessful bidders by the City Treasurer.
- 3. The interest on the Notes is hereby fixed at hundredths percent (4.16 %) per annum.

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- 4. The City Treasurer is hereby directed to deliver the

 Notes to the successful bidder on receipt of Thirteen Million Four

 Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$ 13,450,000)
- 5. The total appropriations of the General Fund of City for the fiscal year 1975-76 are \$\frac{117,904,508}{}. The amount of the Notes hereby authorized to be issued does not exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of the total appropriations of The City of San Diego for the fiscal year 1975-76. The City of San Diego has no other tax anticipation notes outstanding issued under Section 92 of the Charter or otherwise.
- 6. That paragraph 10 of Resolution No. 213736, dated July 3, 1975, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:
 - "10. The Notes shall be dated July 30, 1975, and shall be in the denomination of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) each, or any multiple thereof, at the option of the successful bidder and shall be paid by City on May 21, 1976. They shall bear interest at a rate not to exceed five percent (5%) per annum from the date of said Notes to and including May 21, 1976, computed on the basis of a 360-day year."
- 7. The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to publish this resolution once at least ten (10) days after its adoption in the City Official Newspaper, a newspaper of general circulation published in said City.
