

RESOLUTION NO. 213865

WHEREAS, in recent months there has been an exodus of human care and social service agencies away from the Central City area; and

WHEREAS, these moves were the result of inadequate facilities within the Central City area to maintain these agencies; and

WHEREAS, if this trend continues there may be a significant disruption of vital social services to the residents of the Central City; and

WHEREAS, there is a need for a comprehensive plan to retain these human care agencies within the Central City; and

WHEREAS, there is not presently any program or method to encourage these agencies to remain in the Central City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is concerned about the impact of these moves and recognizes the need to revitalize not only the commercial core of the city, but the human side as well;
NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the City Manager, pursuant to City Charter Section 43(b), is hereby authorized and directed to establish a citizens task force for the purpose of recommending to the Council of said City methods by which the City can retain adequate facilities for service agencies within the Central City.

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
