WHEREAS, an intensive six-week program in urban transportation for training professionals concerned with various aspects of transportation has been developed by the Transportation Research Institute of Carnegie-Mellon University; and

WHEREAS, the Urban Mass Transportation Administration,
United States Department of Transportation, has evaluated the
Carnegie-Mellon Professional Program in Urban Transportation
and finds it appropriate for fellowship support; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. The City Manager of said City be and he is hereby authorized to submit an application for financial assistance to the United States Department of Transportation for the purpose of obtaining a fellowship for the Transportation Department Engineer or his representative to attend the Carnegie-Mellon University Professional Program in Urban Transportation in accordance with Document No. 752371, on file in the office of the City Clerk.

 whatever additional applications or arrangements which may be
 required.
- 3. The City Auditor and Comptroller is hereby authorized to transfer \$4,695 from General Purpose Revolving Fund 534 to the Transportation Department (33.40), Object Account No. 3213 (scheduled travel), subject to reimbursement from grant funds.
