Charles T. McAfee	TRANSPORTATION	\$460	A year ago Mr. McAfee received an initial award of \$500 for his suggestion to replace Mobil sweeper elevator assemblies with Wayne assemblies which last much longer. It has been found that the \$9584 per year saving has been made, and a \$460 additional award should be made.
Delber C. Chipman	ENG. & DEVELOPMENT DEPT. Field Engineering Div.	\$75	Mr. Chipman, a Surveyor II, suggested a layout template be made for traffic loops in City streets. This makes marking the loops on the surface much easier for the survey crew, and saves an estimated \$750 per year.
George R. Allen	EMPLOYEE SERVICES	\$45	Mr. Allen, a Senior Clerk, noted that several voluminous data runs of payroll information were being routed to the department office, but were not needed. He initiated the elimination of these copies of (5) runs, saving \$450 worth of paper per year.
Robert A. Furtak	POLICE DEPARTMENT	\$50	Sergeant Furtak suggested that a copy of the daily court calendar be provided for first watch line-ups. This is then used by officers who have subpoenas and the courts in a way that minimizes time lost previously by officers scheduled to appear in court. An estimated \$504 per year is saved.
Lester L. Barker	PURCHASING DEPARTMENT	\$20	Mr. Barker, a Storekeeper, suggested a better means of identifying City employees authorized to make purchases at City stores. This has been done to reduce time
