BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that in the event the California Office of Criminal Justice Planning consents to fund the above project from funds made available through the Omnibus CrimeControl and Safe Streets Act, The City of San Diego agrees to accept the grant and designates the City Manager to execute, for and on behalf of said City, the contract for the grant for law enforcement purposes, including any extensions or amendments thereof.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that The City of San Diego agrees to provide the required matching funds to said project, including any extension or amendments thereof.

authorized to use \$12,924 to meet the cash match requirements
of this grant which is budgeted in the Police Department's
Fiscal Year 1976 Budget, and is included in the total
second-year project cost of \$258,484.
