BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

That the City Council adopts findings of fact pursuant to Municipal Code, Section 102.0302.5, as follows:

- The land involved is not subject to flooding, sliding, slipping or other similar hazards.
- 2. The map conforms substantially in its purpose and design to the general plan and the various elements thereof and to the community plans which have been approved by the Planning Commission and City Council. Approval of this parcel map will not affect adversely the public health, safety or welfare.
- 3. The parcels on the parcel map comply with all applicable lot design standards as set forth in the San Diego Municipal Code.
- 4. The Planning Director, Planning Commission and
 City Council have found this parcel map suitable for submission
 as a final parcel map.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a setback of 15 feet from the property line adjacent to Alexandria Drive shall be observed and shall be reflected on the parcel map.
