RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE SPECIAL MUNICIPAL BOND ELECTION HELD IN SAN DIEGO ON NOVEMBER 4, 1975.

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WHEREAS, this Council by Ordinance No. 11663 (New Series) adopted August 21, 1975, called a Special Municipal Bond Election to be held in the City on November 4, 1975; and

WHEREAS, this Special Municipal Bond Election was duly consolidated with the General Municipal Election held upon the same date; and

WHEREAS, the Special Municipal Bond Election was held on November 4, 1975, for the purpose of proposing and submitting to the qualified electors of the City the following proposition to incur indebtedness and issue bonds in the principal amount indicated therein as follows:

PROPOSITION A

PROPOSITION A. CITY OF SAN DIEGO BOND PRO-POSAL FOR THE PURCHASE OF CERTAIN COMMUNITY CONCOURSE PROPERTIES:

To achieve savings in overall financing costs and to increase funds available for capital projects, shall the City incur a bonded indebtedness in the principal amount of Eleven Million Six Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars to accomplish the immediate purchase from bond funds of certain Community Concourse properties which constitute a City Plan?

This proposition requires a two-thirds vote.

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WHEREAS, a copy of the certificate of the Registrar of Voters of the County of San Diego canvassing the returns of the Special Municipal Bond Election, including absentee votes cast, as certified to the City Clerk, has been duly received; and

WHEREAS, a canvass of the Special Municipal Bond Election has been completed and the City Clerk has certified the results to the City Council; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the Council finds and determines pursuant to the provisions of Section 27.2206 of the San Diego Municipal Code, as follows:

- l. The whole number of votes including absentee votes cast in the City of San Diego Special Municipal Bond Election is ________.
- 2. The number of votes including absentee votes cast for and against the bond proposition which appeared on the ballot as proposition lettered A, and the total number of votes cast upon the bond proposition, including absentee votes, is as follows:
