RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, MAKING FINDINGS AND OVERRULING PROTESTS AND OBJECTIONS, CONFIRMING DIAGRAM AND ASSESSMENT AND ORDERING IMPROVEMENTS.

Park District No. 11 (Navajo Canyon)

WHEREAS, in proceedings under the San Diego Park
District Procedural Ordinance of 1969 and, in particular,
Division 8 (commencing with Section 61.0801) of Article 1,
Chapter VI of the San Diego Municipal Code, the Council
adopted resolution of intention, Resolution No. 214539,
ordering the Superintendent of Streets to prepare the
Report required by said ordinance and pursuant thereto
the Superintendent of Streets prepared the Report, consisting
of plans and specifications describing the proposed acquisitions and improvements, an estimate of the costs and expenses
thereof, a diagram showing the assessment district, and a
proposed assessment of such costs and expenses, the Report
being on file with the City Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the Council by Resolution No. 214600 approved the Report, as filed, and appointed a time and place of hearing thereon and also for a public hearing on the question of whether public convenience and necessity require

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such improvements and whether the Special Assessment Investigation, Limitation and Majority Protest Act of 1931 and the debt limitation and majority protest provisions thereof shall apply; and

WHEREAS, notices of the passage of Resolutions

Nos. 214599and 214600were duly published, posted and mailed, as provided by said ordinance, and the hearings were duly held at the time and place so fixed and all continuances thereof, if any, were duly made and ordered; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Environmental Quality Act of 1970 (commencing with Section 21050, Public Resources Code) and the Environmental Impact Report Procedural Ordinance (commencing with Section 69.0101, San Diego Municipal Code) the Environmental Quality Department of the city has determined that the proposed project is exempt from the environmental assessment process of the city; and

WHEREAS, at the hearings all persons desiring to be heard were fully heard and all oral and written protests and objections, if any, were fully heard and this Council gave all persons present an opportunity to hear and be heard in respect to the Report, the diagram and assessment, the proposed acquisitions and improvements, the boundaries

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of the proposed assessment district, the serial bonds to be issued to represent unpaid assessments, the question of whether public convenience and necessity require such improvements, whether the Special Assessment Investigation, Limitation and Majority Protest Act of 1931 and the debt limitation and majority protest provisions thereof shall apply, or in any way relating to the Report and the proceedings proposed by the resolution of intention; and

WHEREAS, the Council has received evidence relating to the Report, the proposed acquisitions and improvements, the boundaries of the proposed assessment district, the assessment, and the benefits to the property to be included in the proposed assessment district; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego as follows:

Section 1. Written protest or objection against the proposed acquisitions and improvements has not been made by the owners of more than one-half of the area of the land to be assessed for the improvements. Except to the extent of any changes ordered by the Council, each and all oral and written protests and objections, if any, made or filed in the matter are hereby overruled and denied.

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Section 2. The assessment and diagram are hereby confirmed.

Section 3. The Council hereby declares that the Report, is approved and orders the acquisitions and improvements to be made as described in the resolution of intention and the Report. Reference is hereby made to the resolution of intention and the Report for a full and complete description and for further particulars.
