Hope Park (Dennis V. Allen) Improvement Project as attached to Resolution No. 211855 is hereby revised as set forth in the attached Exhibit C (Project Work Program, Performance Standards, and Project Progress Report).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that aside from the above stated modifications, all other terms and conditions set forth in Resolution Nos. 211853, 211854, and 211855 shall remain the same.
