AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE 2 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY REPEALING DIVISION 21, SECTIONS 22.2101 AND 22.2102; BY ADDING A NEW DIVISION 21 AND A NEW SECTION 22.2101 ESTABLISHING A COUNCIL ADMINISTRATION DIVISION; BY AMENDING SECTION 22.1801; SAID CHANGES TO REFLECT THE DELETION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF COUNCILMANIC ADMINISTRATION AND THE TRANSFER OF THOSE FUNCTIONS TO THE DEPUTY MAYOR COUNCILMANIC DEPARTMENT.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter II, Article 2 of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by repealing the following division and sections:

DIVISION 21

DEPARTMENT OF COUNCILMANIC ADMINISTRATION

- SEC. 22.2101 DEPARTMENT OF COUNCILMANIC ADMINISTRATION
- SEC. 22.2102 POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE DIRECTOR OF COUNCILMANIC ADMINISTRATION

Section 2. That Chapter II, Article 2 of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 22.1801 to read as follows:

SEC. 22.1801 CITY DEPARTMENTS

- a. Purpose and Intent. It is the purpose and intent of the City Council to enumerate the existing departments of the City because of repeated reference in City legislation and operation to such departments.

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b. The following are the departments of The City of San Diego within the meaning of the Charter and the ordinances of said City:

Auditor and Comptroller

Building Inspection

Citizens Assistance and Information

City Attorney

City Clerk

City Council - District 1

City Council - District 2

City Council - District 3

City Council - District 4

City Council - District 5

City Council - District 6

City Council - District 7

City Council - District 8

Data Processing

Employee Services

Engineering and Development

Executive Services

Financial Management

Fire

General Services

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Human Resources

c. The department head for each department of City Council - Districts 1 through 8 shall be the duly elected and/or appointed Councilman or Councilwoman from the district.

Section 3. That Chapter II, Article 2 of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby further amended by adding Division 21, Section 22.2101 to read as follows:

DIVISION 21

COUNCIL ADMINISTRATION DIVISION

SEC. 22.2101 COUNCIL ADMINISTRATION DIVISION

There is hereby established a Division of Council Administration as a support element to the Deputy Mayor. The division shall be under the administrative and policy direction of the Deputy Mayor and shall be

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
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responsible for coordinating all the intragovernmental and intergovernmental administrative functions of the City Council and the several departments thereof. The division shall provide coordination and liaison as directed by the Deputy Mayor and the personnel of such division as may be authorized by virtue of the annual appropriation ordinance shall be reflected in the budget of the Deputy Mayor.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
