AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 11650 (NEW SERIES), AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1975-76 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR," BY TRANSFERRING SURPLUS PRIOR-YEAR FUNDS ENCUMBERED THEREIN TO AND WITHIN THE HUMAN RESOURCES DEPARTMENT FOR THE PURPOSE OF AUGMENTING 05.61, HUMAN CARE SERVICES PROGRAM, SOUTHEAST INVOLVEMENT PROJECT.

WHEREAS, on December 17, 1975, the Public Services and Safety Committee (PS&S) recommended continued City funding of the Southeast Involvement Project (SIP) from February 1, 1976 through June 30, 1976; and

WHEREAS, the sum of money required to continue said SIP funding for the five-month period is \$49,000; and

WHEREAS, the allocation and expenditure of said sum of \$49,000 would create a deficit in the fiscal year 1976 Human Resources Department Revenue Sharing Account in the amount of \$43,111; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager recommended to the PS&S Committee and said committee approved the recommendation to transfer the sum of \$43,111 of surplus prior-year encumbered funds from the fiscal year 1975 Recreation Support Program, 100 Fund, Department 05.61 to fiscal year 1976, 100 Fund, Department 05.61 for the purpose of alleviating said deficit; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:



Section 1. That the Southeast Involvement Project, Fund 100, Department 05.61 be and the same is hereby extended for the period February 1, 1976 through June 30, 1976 and is further hereby authorized continued City financing for said period.

Section 2. That Ordinance No. 11650 (New Series), as amended, entitled "AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1975-76 AND APPROPRIATING THE NECESSARY MONEY TO OPERATE THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR," be and the same is hereby amended by transferring within the Human Resources Department, Fund 100, Department 05.61 the sum of \$43,111 from surplus prior-year funds encumbered for the fiscal year 1975 Recreation Support Program to the fiscal year 1976 Southeast Involvement Project for the purpose of financing the extension of said project.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.


