AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 11204 (NEW SERIES), ADOPTED JANUARY 8, 1974, INCORPORATING A PORTION OF THE WEST 1/2, SECTION 30, TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, SBBM, IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, INTO R-1-5 ZONE, AS DEFINED BY SECTION 101.0407 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 11204 (New Series), adopted January 8, 1974, provided that the R-1-5 Zone would attach if a final map or maps were recorded on or before February 7, 1976; and

WHEREAS, a request has been received to extend the time within which a final map or maps may be recorded to effect the zone change contemplated by Ordinance No. 11204 (New Series); and

WHEREAS, the requested extension of time will permit the successful conclusion and implementation of the zoning pattern heretofore approved by the Planning Commission;
NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 11204 (New Series), adopted January 8, 1974, be, and it is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. That in the event that a portion of the West 1/2, Section 30, Township 14 South, Range 2 West, SBBM, in the City of San Diego, California



designated "R-1-5" on Zone Map Drawing B-2528.1, is subdivided and a final subdivision map or maps thereof duly recorded on or before February 7, 1977, and within such subdivision provision is made for the installation of public utility services and the dedication of streets, alleys and easements for public use, the provisions of Section 101.0407 of the San Diego Municipal Code shall attach and become applicable to the said subdivided land and the said subdivided land shall be incorporated into R-1-5 Zone, as described by Section 101.0407 of the San Diego Municipal Code, the boundary of such zone to be as indicated on Zone Map Drawing No. B-2528.1, filed in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 745477.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
