AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER III, ARTICLE 3,
DIVISION 15, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE
BY AMENDING SECTIONS 33.1501.3 AND 33.1501.10
RELATING TO REGULATION OF CABARETS.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego,
as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter III, Article 3, Division 15, of
the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended
by amending Sections 33.1501.3 and 33.1501.10 to read as
follows:

SEC. 33.1501.3 CABARET--ENTERTAINERS

It shall be unlawful for the owner, proprietor,
manager or person in charge of a place licensed under
the provisions of this Chapter to employ as entertainers
in such place any person who is not at least eighteen
(18) years of age.

SEC. 33.1501.10 MINORS PROHIBITED

(a) No person conducting, managing, operating
or maintaining a cabaret, herein called "licensee,"
nor any employee of a licensee shall admit into or
permit to be present in such cabaret any person under
the age of eighteen (18) years unless such person is
accompanied by his parent or spouse or legal guardian
all over the age of eighteen (18) years.

(b) No person shall falsely represent his age, the age of another person or his relationship to another person in or at the entrance to a cabaret, for the purpose of obtaining admittance of any person to or service in a cabaret, or for the purpose of obtaining employment in a cabaret.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.


