AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AND APPROVING
CERTIFIED RETIREMENT SYSTEM ELECTION
RESULTS AND INCREASING THE RETIREMENT
ALLOWANCES OF FIXED PENSION RETIREES.

WHEREAS, The Council received a communication from the President of The City of San Diego Retired Employees regarding the plight of low-pension retirees; and

WHEREAS, in response to said communication, the Council directed the Retirement Board of Administration (herein called Board) for the City Employees' Retirement System (herein called System), by Council Resolution No. 213862, to take appropriate steps necessary to increase the minimum pension for general members of the System after twenty years of service to \$150 per month; and

WHEREAS, the Board considered this matter on October 17, 1975 and determined that Charter Section 143.1 necessitated a vote of the members of said System when benefits are to be changed; and

WHEREAS, the Board directed that an official ballot and election report on the matter be submitted to the City Council for approval prior to distribution to members of the System for a vote thereon; and

WHEREAS, the Council by Resolution No. 214717 approved the official ballot and election report to be submitted to the members; and

WHEREAS, said ballot provided for a choice between member funding or City funding of the proposed increase; and

WHEREAS, the election was conducted and votes were tabulated on January 19, 1976; and

WHEREAS, the results of the election approved the granting of the increase to \$150 per month to affected pensioners, said increase to be funded entirely by the City; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

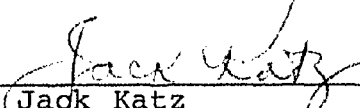
Section 1. That the certified results of the election conducted by the Board of the members of the System for the proposal to increase the minimum retirement allowance to \$150 per month for all general members who retired prior to July 1, 1971 with twenty years or more of creditable service with costs to be borne by the City contributions is hereby accepted and approved, said vote as indicated in Exhibit A hereto.

Section 2. That all general member pensioners who retired prior to July 1, 1971 with twenty years or more creditable service, and surviving spouses thereof, who are presently receiving fixed pensions of less than \$150 per month, shall, and they are hereby authorized to have their pensions increased to the sum of \$150 per month.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

WHEREAS, The Council received a communication from the President of The City of San Diego Employees regarding the needs of low pension retirees; and WHEREAS, in response to said communication, the Council created the Retirement Board of Administration (herein called Board) for the City Employees Retirement System (herein called System), by Council Resolution No. 21402, to take appropriate steps necessary to increase the minimum pension for general members of the System after twenty years of service to \$150 per month; and

WHEREAS, The Board considered this matter on October 12, 1976 and determined that Charter Section 143.1 necessitates a vote of the members of said System when benefits are to be increased; and

WHEREAS, the Board directed that an official ballot and election report on the matter be submitted to the City Council for approval prior to distribution to members of the System for a vote thereon; and

WHEREAS, the Council by Resolution No. 21417 approved the official ballot and election report to be submitted to the members; and

WHEREAS, said ballot provided for a choice between member funding or City funding of the proposed increase; and

WHEREAS, the election was conducted and votes were tabulated on January 19, 1976; and

WHEREAS, the results of the election approved the granting of the increase to \$150 per month to affected pensioners, said increase to be funded entirely by the City NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the certified results of the election conducted by the Board of the members of the System for the proposal to increase the minimum retirement allowance to \$150 per month for all general members who retired prior to July 1, 1971 with twenty years or more of creditable service with costs to be borne by the City contributions is hereby accepted and approved, said vote as indicated in Exhibit A hereto.

Section 2. That all general member pensioners who retired prior to July 1, 1971 with twenty years or more creditable service, and surviving spouses thereof, who are presently receiving fixed pensions of less than \$150 per month, shall, and they are hereby authorized to have their pensions increased to the sum of \$150 per month.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
