AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER IV, ARTICLE 1 OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY REPEALING SECTION 41.09; BY AMENDING SECTIONS 41.08.1, 41.08.2, 41.12 AND 41.13; AND BY ADDING SECTIONS 41.09 AND 41.16.1, ALL RELATING TO REGULATIONS FOR FOOD HANDLERS.

WHEREAS, The City of San Diego has entered into a Basic Health Agreement with the County of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to such agreement, the County Health
Officer (Director of Public Health of the County of San Diego),
is designated as the City Health Officer for The City of San
Diego with the authority to enforce City health ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the Basic Health Agreement requires the City to adopt ordinances equivalent to ordinances adopted by the County; and

WHEREAS, on November 18, 1975, the County Board of Supervisors adopted Ordinance No. 4610 (New Series), which amends sections of the San Diego County Code of Regulatory Ordinances relating to food handlers, requiring a screening test for tuberculosis before a Food Handler Authorization Card will be issued and requiring a medical examination if the Director of Public Health determines there is danger of a transmissible disease; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter IV, Article 1 of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by repealing the following section:

SEC. 41.09 MEDICAL EXAMINATION

Section 2. That Chapter IV, Article 1 of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Sections 41.08.1, 41.08.2, 41.12 and 41.13 to read as follows:

SEC. 41.08.1 FOOD HANDLERS REQUIRED TO OBTAIN AN AUTHORIZATION CARD

No person shall act as or be engaged as a food handler unless such person holds a Food Handler Authorization Card issued by the Department of Public Health, or by such other qualified person or agency as may be designated by the Director of Public Health. No authorization issued pursuant to this section shall be valid for more than four (4) years from the date of issuance thereof. A "Food Handler Registration Card," issued by the Department of Public Health within the four (4) years immediately preceding the effective date of this chapter, and not revoked, shall be deemed to be an authorization within the meaning of this section.

The following persons shall be exempt from the provisions of this section:

- a. Food handlers engaged in the production, harvesting or packaging of fruits or vegetables either in the fields or in packing houses.
- b. Food handlers engaged in drying or dehydrating fruits or vegetables on the premises where such fruits or vegetables are produced.

- c. Food handlers engaged in the production, slaughtering, packing, distribution, or sale of poultry or poultry products.
- d. Food handlers engaged in the production, harvesting, packaging or sale of fruits or vegetables on the premises where such fruits or vegetables are produced.
- e. A retail food production or marketing establishment as defined in Section 28802 of the California Health and Safety Code.

SEC. 41.08.2 MEDICAL EXAMINATION REQUIRED

Applicants for Food Handler Authorization Cards shall submit to an intradermal tuberculin skin test or an x-ray, as appropriate, performed by the department or by such other qualified person or agency as may be designated by the Director of Public Health. Such intradermal tuberculin skin test or x-ray shall be repeated every four years.

SEC. 41.12 DIRECTOR MAY REQUIRE EXAMINATION

The Director of Public Health may require the holder of a Food Handler Authorization Card to submit to medical examination when there is reason to believe that such person has contracted a transmissible disease.

SEC. 41.13 CONTRACTION OF TRANSMISSIBLE DISEASE SUBSEQUENT TO EXAMINATION; SUSPENSION OR REVOCATION OF CARD

The Director of Public Health may suspend or revoke the Food Handler Authorization Card of any person

suspected of having contracted a transmissible disease. The Director shall reinstate the registration card upon presentation of satisfactory proof that the person suspected is free of the transmissible disease. The Director may require that any suspended or revoked Authorization to act as a food handler be surrendered to the Director.

Section 3. That Chapter IV, Article 1 of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by adding Sections 41.09 and 41.16.1 to read as follows:

SEC. 41.09 TRANSMISSIBLE DISEASE

No person who has contracted or is afflicted with a disease or infection determined by the Director to be a danger to public health transmissible either directly or through food or drink to other persons, or who is known or suspected to be a carrier of organisms causing such disease, or who has come in contact with any person afflicted with such transmissible disease or infection, shall act or be engaged or employed as a food handler.

SEC. 41.16.1 EMPLOYMENT OF FOOD HANDLERS

No person who owns or operates a business, occupation or establishment for which a permit is required by Division 1, Article 2 of this chapter shall employ, permit or authorize any person to act or be engaged as a food handler in said business, occupation or establishment unless such person has an authorization to act as a food handler as

provided in Section 41.08.1 unless such person is exempt from the requirement to hold and carry such authorization pursuant to Section 41.08.1.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
