AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER V, ARTICLE 1,
OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING
SECTION 51.0102 RELATING TO DEFINITION OF
EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego,
as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter V, Article 1, of the San Diego
Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending
Section 51.0102 to read as follows:

SEC. 51.0102 DEFINITION

As used in this Article, "emergency" shall mean
the actual or threatened existence of conditions of
disaster or of extreme peril to the public peace,
health or safety of persons or property within this
City caused by, but not limited to, such conditions
as air pollution, fire, flood, storm, epidemic, riot,
or earthquake, or other conditions, including condi-
tions resulting from war or imminent threat of war.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in
force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
