AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER X, ARTICLE 1 OF THE
SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 101.0510
RELATING TO ASSIGNMENT OF PUBLIC HEARING RESPONSIBILITY
INVOLVING TWO OR MORE BODIES.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego,
as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter X, Article 1, be and it is hereby
amended by amending Section 101.0510 to read as follows:

SEC. 101.0510 ASSIGNMENT OF PUBLIC HEARING RESPONSIBILITY
INVOLVING TWO OR MORE BODIES

A. Application for Conditional Use Permit which
includes uses which may be considered for Conditional Use
Permit by more than one body shall be considered by the
following listed body:

1. By the Planning Commission if the uses are
assigned to the Zoning Administrator and the Planning
Commission.

2. By the City Council, after hearing and
recommendation by the Planning Commission, if the
uses are assigned to the Zoning Administrator and
the City Council.

3. By the City Council, after hearing and
recommendation by the Planning Commission, if the
uses are assigned to the Planning Commission and
City Council.

4. By the City Council, after hearing and
recommendation by the Planning Commission, if the

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uses are assigned to the Zoning Administrator, Planning Commission, and City Council.

B. The procedure to be followed in considering the application for a Conditional Use Permit involving uses assigned to two or more bodies shall be as set forth in the following sections:

1. Section 101.0506 if the Conditional Use Permit is considered by the Planning Commission.

2. Section 101.0507 if the Conditional Use Permit is considered by the City Council.


C. Application for other combinations of special permits and zone variances which involve public hearing responsibility on the part of two or more bodies shall be considered in accordance with the provisions of paragraph A of this section.

D. The procedure to be followed in considering a combined application shall be that set forth in Section 101.0506 of the Code.

E. For a combined hearing the required findings shall be the total findings required by all the special permits and zone variance procedures involved in the combined hearing.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

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

B. The procedure to be followed in considering the application for a Conditional Use Permit involving uses assigned to two or more bodies shall be as set forth in the following sections:

1. Section 101.0506 if the Conditional Use Permit is considered by the Planning Commission.
2. Section 101.0507 if the Conditional Use Permit is considered by the City Council.

C. Application for other combinations of special permits and zone variances which involve public hearing responsibility on the part of two or more bodies shall be considered in accordance with the provisions of paragraph A of this section.

D. The procedure to be followed in considering a combined application shall be that set forth in Section 101.0506 of the Code.

E. For a combined hearing the required findings shall be the total findings required by all the special permits and zone variance procedures involved in the combined hearing.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
