2 WEST, PALM AVENUE.


WHEREAS, in order to make a corner rounding from Beyer
Boulevard to Palm Avenue, in connection with the widening of
Palm Avenue, it is necessary that approximately 97 square feet
of Luckie Waller Memorial Park be dedicated for street purposes;
NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego,
as follows:

Section 1. That a portion of the Northeast Quarter of the
Northeast Quarter of Section 27, Township 18 South, Range 2 West,
San Bernardino Base and Meridian, in the City of San Diego, County
of San Diego, State of California, according to United States
Government Survey, as more particularly described in the legal
description attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein,
be and the same is hereby set aside and dedicated as and for a
public street and the same is hereby named PALM AVENUE.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force
on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.

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

Section 1. That a portion of the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 27, Township 18 South, Range 2 West, San Bernardino Base and Meridian, in the City of San Diego, County of San Diego, State of California, according to United States Government Survey, as more particularly described in the legal description attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein, be and the same is hereby set aside and dedicated as and for a public street and the same is hereby named PALM AVENUE.
