AN ORDINANCE SETTING ASIDE AND DEDICATING CERTAIN LANDS IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, FOR A PUBLIC PARK AND NAMING SAID PARK "CALUMET PARK."

WHEREAS, The City of San Diego is the owner of certain lands in the City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the people of The City of San Diego to set aside and dedicate forever portions of said lands, hereinafter described, for public use and enjoyment as and for a public park to be used by all the public for park and recreational purposes; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the hereinafter described real property be, and the same is hereby set aside and dedicated in perpetuity as a public park to be used by all the public for park and recreational purposes.

Section 2. That the hereinafter described real property be and the same is hereby named "CALUMET PARK."

Section 3. That the real property so dedicated and named is described as Lot 30, Calumet Park, according to Map thereof No. 8169, as filed in the Office of the San Diego County Recorder on September 5, 1975.

Section 4. That the City Clerk of said City be and he is hereby authorized and directed to file for record in the office


