SEC. 23.1208 SUSPENSION PENDING INVESTIGATION (Rule XI, Section 8 of the Rules of the Civil Service Commission)

Any officer or employee of the City may be suspended without pay, for up to thirty (30) calendar days, pending investigation of charges of misconduct, when in the opinion of the appointing authority such suspension is necessary in order to maintain the safety of the community or the reputation, morale, or harmony of the organization. Such suspension is neat a disciplinary action and may not be appealed to the Commission. If the charges are substantiated, disciplinary action may be taken in accordance with the other provisions of this rule. If the charges are unfounded, the employee shall be restored to duty and paid for the term of the suspension.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
