AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER III, ARTICLE 2
OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING
SECTION 32.01 RELATING TO ALLOCATION OF SALES
TAX REVENUES.

WHEREAS, on October 27, 1976, the City Council directed its staff to negotiate an agreement with the County of San Diego for the construction of a minimum 150,000 net square foot office building and a supportive parking facility; and,

WHEREAS, an agreement has been negotiated and the agreement provides that the City will contribute, through its Redevelopment Agency, one million dollars to be used by the County to offset, in part, its construction costs of such office building; and,

WHEREAS, it is proposed that the City's one million dollar contribution be funded from that portion of the sales tax revenues generated in fiscal 1977-78 which are normally allocated to the City's Capital Outlay Fund 245; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter III, Article 2 of the San Diego Municipal Code be and the same is hereby amended by amending Section 32.01 to read as follows:

SEC. 32.01 ALLOCATION OF REVENUE FOR CAPITAL
OUTLAY EXPENDITURES

One-fourth of the total revenue collected from the tax imposed by this article shall be paid into the Capital Outlay Fund and shall be used for capital outlay expenditures

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

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provided, however, that a sufficient portion of said revenue shall be used for annual debt service of bonds issued for the purchase of Community Concourse properties; and provided further that a maximum of one million dollars annually of said revenue may be used the next three fiscal years for replacement of fire suppression heavy motive equipment which has been assigned a service life expectancy of eighteen years and provided further that, in fiscal year 1977-78, one million dollars of said revenue may be used to provide the City's contribution to the County through the Redevelopment Agency to offset, in part, the County's cost of constructing a County office building on the block bounded by First and Front and "B" and "C" Streets, respectively.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.


