AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER III, ARTICLE 3,
DIVISION 16, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE
BY AMENDING SECTION 33.1625.2 RELATING TO
CARDROOM APPLICATION--CONTENTS--LICENSE WORK
PERMIT.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego,
as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter III, Article 3, Division 16, of
the San Diego Municipal Code be and it is hereby amended by
amending Section 33.1625.2 to read as follows:

SEC. 33.1625.2 APPLICATION--CONTENTS--LICENSE WORK PERMIT

An applicant for a cardroom license shall submit his
application to the Chief of Police of The City of San
Diego, which application shall be under oath, and shall
include, among other things, the true names and addresses
of all persons financially interested in the business.
Said application shall also be accompanied by a nonrefund-
able investigation fee of Two Hundred Twenty Dollars (\$220)
in the case of a new cardroom and Twenty Five Dollars (\$25)
in the case of an existing cardroom. The past criminal
record, if any, of all persons financially or otherwise
interested in the business shall be shown on such applica-
tion. The term "persons financially interested" shall
include all persons who share in the profits of the business,
on the basis of gross or net revenue, including landlords,
lessors, lessees, the owner or owners of the building,

fixtures or equipment. The application shall also be accompanied by fingerprints of persons financially interested.

The Chief of Police may deny any applicant for a cardroom license, a license to operate such cardroom when in the opinion of the Chief of Police there appears to be good cause why such person should not operate a cardroom.

Employees in cardrooms must obtain a work permit from the Chief of Police; applications for such work-permits shall be submitted under oath and contain such information as may be deemed by the Chief of Police necessary to determine whether the applicant is a proper person to be employed in a cardroom.

The Chief of Police may deny to such applicant a work permit if, in his opinion, good cause appears why such person should not be permitted to be employed in a cardroom. Each application for a work permit shall be accompanied by a nonrefundable investigation fee of Twenty Dollars (\$20) and said work permit when issued shall be valid for one (1) year. The annual nonrefundable renewal fee shall be Fifteen Dollars (\$15) to defray, in part, the cost of inspection, investigation and enforcement of the cardroom provisions.


