AN ORDINANCE INCREASING THE RETIREMENT
ALLOWANCES OF FIXED PENSION CITY RETIREES.

WHEREAS, in July of 1975, a Council resolution directed the City Manager and City Attorney, in conjunction with the Retirement Officer, to review the provisions of the present system; and

WHEREAS, the Council directed, after consideration of input by the committee, to increase the minimum pension for certain retirement recipients of the San Diego City Employees Retirement System (herein called "System") with more than twenty years of service to \$150 per month; and

WHEREAS, effective with retirement paychecks issued April 30, 1976, all General Member retirees and their surviving spouses who retired prior to July 1, 1971 with over 20 years of service were granted a minimum retirement allowance of \$150 per month; and

WHEREAS, the cost of the increased benefits were borne by The City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, the program has resulted in certain inequities such as the fact that retired employees with under 20 years of service have not had their retirement allowances adjusted; and

WHEREAS, at the request of the Chairman of the ADHOC Committee and the Retired City Employee Association a survey

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of all retired members of the System who retired before July 1, 1971 with between 5 years and 19.9 years of service has been prepared; and

WHEREAS, said survey of those individuals and the resultant fiscal impact upon the City was presented to the Rules Committee on November 1, 1976; and

WHEREAS, the Rules Committee approved unanimously to recommend to the Council that all those retirees and surviving spouses surveyed have their minimum fixed pensions increased on a pro rata scale as contained in the report of the Retirement Officer to the ADHOC Committee dated August 24, 1976, with said increased expense to be borne by City; and

WHEREAS, those retirees and surviving spouses surveyed and reported to the Rules Committee encompass both general and special class safety membership; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. All pensioners of the general membership who retired prior to July 1, 1971, and their surviving spouses, and all special class safety members who have retired prior to or will retire subsequent to the effective date of this ordinance and their surviving spouses, who are presently receiving or will receive fixed pensions, pursuant to applicable provisions of this System, shall, and they are hereby authorized to have their pensions increased on a pro rata scale to minimum monthly amounts indicated as follows:

Section 2. The increases granted in Section 1 of this ordinance are not intended to and shall not diminish any amounts presently received by affected pensioners and surviving spouses, it being the intention of the Council that such allowances as indicated become minimum entitlements.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its passage.
