

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NO. 215117

JAN 21 1976

A RESOLUTION ELECTING TO PROCEED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE STREET VACATION ACT OF 1941, DECLARING THE INTENTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL TO VACATE MAJESTIC DRIVE BETWEEN DEL SOL BOULEVARD AND PICADOR BOULEVARD AND FIXING A TIME AND PLACE FOR HEARING THEREOF.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the public interest and convenience of said City require the vacation of a portion of the street hereinafter mentioned; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that it is the intention of said Council to order the vacation of MAJESTIC DRIVE between Del Sol Boulevard and Picador Boulevard, as more particularly shown on Drawings No. 16694-1-D and 16694-2-D, on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 753975.

The Council hereby elects to proceed, in making said vacation, under the provisions of the "Street Vacation Act of 1941."

The Council hereby fixes 8:30 a.m., FEB 25 1976, in the Council Chamber on the twelfth floor of the City Administration Building, The Charles C. Dail Concourse, 202 C Street, in said City of San Diego, as the time and place for hearing all persons interested in or objecting to the proposed vacation.

That The Daily Transcript, a daily newspaper published and circulated, and of general circulation, in the said City of San Diego, be, and it is hereby designated as the newspaper in which the Street Superintendent of said City shall cause to be published, in the manner and form required by law, notice of the passage of


