WHEREAS, the State of California can execute a change order to its contract and perform the necessary improvements of PICADOR BOULEVARD in an expeditious and economical manner; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That the City Manager be and he is hereby authorized and empowered to execute, for and on behalf of said City, an agreement with the STATE OF CALIFORNIA, acting by and through its Department of Transportation, to include in State's construction of State Highway 75 the roadway construction of PICADOR BOULEVARD, from Route 75 to 1050 feet north, in the City of San Diego, under the terms and conditions set forth in the form of agreement on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No.
- 2. That the expenditure of \$49,220 is hereby authorized out of Gas Tax Fund 220 of The City of San Diego solely and
