WHEREAS, the National Register of Historic Places is the official listing of the districts, sites, buildings, structures and objects significant in American history, architecture, archeology and culture; and

WHEREAS, currently, the California Quadrangle (Museum of Man building) and the Ford Building located in Balboa Park, are listed in the National Register; and

WHEREAS, the Committee of 100 proposes the inclusion of the remaining historic structures in the El Prado complex, as a district, within this listing; and

WHEREAS, the Committee of 100, at its expense, is preparing all the documents required for the proposed application and is offering the items to assist the City in submitting the proposed nomination; and

WHEREAS, the affect of placing this complex in the Register will be to provide additional national recognition and prestige for the El Prado complex and eligibility for federal matching grant-in-aid for the protection, rehabilitation, restoration and/or reconstruction of these facilities; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the nomination of the above-mentioned portions of the El Prado complex in Balboa Park for listing in the National Register of Historic Places be approved and that the Historical Site Board be and the same is hereby directed to submit said nomination.

2. That The City of San Diego hereby accepts the generous offer of the Committee of 100 to prepare on behalf of said City and at no cost to same, all documents necessary for such application.

3. That this Council does hereby commend the Committee of 100 for this act of civic generosity and does hereby publically express on behalf of the citizens of San Diego a debt of gratitude to it.
