BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego as follows:

That the expenditure of \$8,800 is hereby authorized out of Transient Occupancy Tax Fund 224 (Contingency Reserve) of The City of San Diego, solely and exclusively, to cover expenditures in connection with the AMERICAN FREEDOM TRAIN, said \$8,800 being in excess of the \$27,000 originally authorized.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager be, and he is hereby authorized and empowered to undertake by means of City Forces, the repair of that certain drill field at NAS Miramar damaged in conjunction with the exhibition of the above-said train, pursuant to the recommendations of the City Manager and the submission of his estimates indicating that said work can be done more economically by City Forces than if let by contract.
