A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO REQUESTING THE CONSOLIDATION OF A SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF RATIFYING CHARTER AMENDMENTS, TO BE HELD IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ON JUNE 8, 1976, WITH THE STATEWIDE PRIMARY ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THE SAME DATE; AUTHORIZING THE AUDITOR AND COMPTROLLER TO TRANSFER THE SUM OF \$20,000 WITHIN THE 100 FUND FROM THE UNALLOCATED RESERVE (53.31) TO THE CITY CLERK, ELECTIONS (03.90) FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING ADDITIONAL FUNDS TO PAY THE CHARGES OF THE COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO, REGISTRAR OF VOTERS, FOR THE CONSOLIDATION OF THE ABOVÉ ELECTION.

WHEREAS, at a meeting of the City Council held on March 3, 1976, the Council indicated its intention to submit to the qualified voters of the City of San Diego certain propositions amending the Charter of The City of San Diego at a special municipal election to be held in the City on June 8, 1976; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that this special municipal election be consolidated with the statewide primary election to be held on the same date and that within the City of San Diego the election precincts, polling places, voting booths and election officials for the two elections be the same, and that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego be authorized to canvass the returns of the special municipal election and that this special municipal election and the statewide primary election be held in all respects as if there were only one election; and

WHEREAS, additional funds in the sum of \$20,000 will be required to conduct said consolidated election due to new

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Federal requirements that all material be printed and published in the Spanish language in addition to higher costs for printing; and

WHEREAS, this Council within the time required by law has or will adopt an ordinance calling for a special municipal election and consolidating it with the statewide primary election; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego is hereby requested to consolidate the special municipal election to be held in the City of San Diego on June 8, 1976 with the statewide primary election to be held on the same date, for the purpose of amending the Charter of The City of San Diego.
- 2. The exact forms of the three propositions to be voted upon at this special municipal election and as they are to appear on the ballot are as follows:

PROPOSITION CITY OF SAN DIEGO CHARTER AMENDMENT. ADDS SECTION 129.1 TO THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO. Prohibits strikes by City employees. Authorizes dismissal of striking employ-YES ees in accordance with applicable provisions of the Charter. Provides that employees be assured and accorded due process of law. Provides further that no official of the City shall have authority to grant amnesty to any City employee who has violated the "No Strike" provision of this Charter and excludes appeals to the Civil Service Commission from disciplinary action authorized by this section. Prohibits Council from granting any increases over those in effect or last offered NO by the City prior to any strike or concerted action and further prohibits any increases beyond that in effect or last offered until the following year meet and confer negotiations.

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Each of the propositions shall be designated on the ballot by a letter printed on the left margin of the square containing the description of the measure as provided in Section 10219 of the Elections Code of the State of California.

- 3. That the Board of Supervisors is hereby authorized to canvass the returns of this special municipal election and is requested to conduct the elections in all respects as if there were only one election using only one form of ballot.
- 4. That the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Diego is requested to issue to all officers of the County charged with duties pertaining to the statewide primary election appropriate instructions to take any and all steps necessary for the holding of a consolidated election.
- 5. That the City Clerk of The City of San Diego is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this resolution with the Board of Supervisors and Registrar of Voters of the County of San Diego.
- 6. That the Auditor and Comptroller be and he is hereby authorized to transfer within the General Fund 100 the sum of \$20,000 from the Unallocated Reserve (53.31) to City Clerk, Elections (03.90) for the purpose of providing additional funds to pay the charges of the County of San Diego, Registrar of Voters, for the consolidation of the above election.
