Adopted on APR 7 1976.


BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego as follows:

That five representatives of the Police Department be authorized to travel to San Francisco, California, during the period April 12 through April 16, 1976, for the purpose of attending a Hostage Negotiating Course.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Auditor and Comptroller be and he is hereby authorized to expend the sum of \$1,448 from the General Purpose Revolving Fund (534) for the purpose of defraying expenses incurred in the above travel.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the total cost of said travel, including 60% of the police officers' salaries, shall be reimbursed to the City of San Diego by the Peace Officers Standards and Training (POST).
