WHEREAS, on May 31, 1976, certain private leases in Mission Bay will expire after 50 years; and

WHEREAS, some members of the public have expressed concern that the City may be considering new agreements for the exclusive use of these lands; and

WHEREAS, other members of the public have expressed the desire for new agreements to extend the exclusive use of these lands; and

WHEREAS, these leased tidelands, affecting approximately
25 acres of shoreline and submerged lands, are subject to the
trust conditions imposed by the State in 1945, and also subject
to City Ordinance No. 8628 (New Series) which dedicated Mission Bay
Park as a park in 1962; and

WHEREAS, because of these restrictions, said leases will not and cannot be renewed, and new leases will not and cannot be granted, and new agreements will not and cannot be negotiated, to provide for the exclusive and private use of these tidelands; and

WHEREAS, the separate question of the disposition of the piers and docks within said tidelands which has been the subject of public hearings by the Mission Bay Committee and the Park and Recreation Board, and the related question of future development plans for said tidelands, will be dealt with by the City Council after public hearings; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to put to rest any unfounded anxieties in the public's mind about the matter of these leases and the status of these lands; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of The City of San Diego, that the leased tidelands in question shall, upon the expiration of said leases May 31, 1976, become the public property of all of the people to be used only for public park purposes from that date forward, subject to the restrictions imposed on such recreational tidelands by the State trust and by the City's park dedication ordinance.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the subject of the required demolition of the existing piers and docks in the leased area is hereby referred to the Public Facilities and Recreation Committee to be considered at its meeting of April 26, 1976.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to apply for such Coastal Commission permits as may be necessary in order to remove the piers and docks and to take whatever action he deems appropriate to expedite compliance with the requirements of the Coastal Commission.
