A RESOLUTION ELECTING TO PROCEED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE STREET VACATION ACT OF 1941, DECLARING THE INTENTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL TO VACATE OLYMPIC AVENUE WESTERLY OF CRAWFORD STREET TO THE SOUTHERLY EXTENSION OF THE WESTERLY LOT LINE OF LOT 24, BLOCK 20; ALLEY IN BLOCK 20 EASTERLY OF THE SOUTHERLY PROLONGATION OF THE WESTERLY LINE OF LOT 14; AND THE WESTERLY EIGHT FEET OF CRAWFORD STREET BETWEEN ZION AVENUE AND THE EASTERLY PROLONGATION OF THE SOUTHERLY LINE OF OLYMPIC AVENUE; ALL BEING IN GRANTVILLE AND OUTLOTS; AND FIXING A TIME AND PLACE FOR HEARING THEREOF.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, that the public interest and convenience of said City require the vacation of a portion of the streets hereinafter mentioned.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that it is the intention of said

Council to order the vacation of OLYMPIC AVENUE westerly of Crawford

Street to the southerly extension of the westerly lot line of Lot 24,

Block 20; ALLEY in Block 20 easterly of the southerly prolongation of

the westerly line of Lot 14; and the westerly eight feet of CRAWFORD

STREET between Zion Avenue and the easterly prolongation of the

southerly line of Olympic Avenue, all being in Grantville and Outlots,

as more particularly shown on Map No. 13616-B, on file in the office

of the City Clerk as Document No.

The Council hereby elects to proceed, in making said vacation, under the provisions of the "Street Vacation Act of 1941."

The Council hereby fixes 2 p.m., MAY 2 5 1976, in the Council Chamber on the twelfth floor of the City Administration Building, The Charles C. Dail Concourse, 202 C Street, in said City of San Diego, as the time and place for hearing all persons interested in or objecting to the proposed vacation.
