

RESOLUTION NO. 215966

MAY 17 1976

OPPOSING THE NUCLEAR INITIATIVE TO BE
CONSIDERED BY THE VOTERS OF THE STATE
OF CALIFORNIA AT THE JUNE 8, 1976, DIRECT
PRIMARY ELECTION, AND URGING REJECTION
THEREOF.

WHEREAS, most of our electric power is generated by
oil and gas, and expanded use of these fuels is not considered
practicable due to limited supplies and increasing costs; and

WHEREAS, a safe, economic and dependable source of
power from uranium is available to substitute for oil and gas
generation through its use in effective and reliable nuclear
reactor systems; and

WHEREAS, nuclear generation plants have a proven
safety record and can greatly reduce the amount of air pollu-
tion in the State of California; and

WHEREAS, the expanded use of nuclear fuel can reduce
the burden of importing vast amounts of expensive oil from
unreliable foreign sources; and

WHEREAS, the Nuclear Initiative on the June, 1976,
ballot would, if passed, virtually ban the construction of
nuclear power plants in California and place severe limita-
tions on the operation of existing plants that have already
proven safe; and

WHEREAS, said ban and shutdown would have serious
economic consequences for all of us because existing nuclear
facilities would have to be paid for anyway, and additional



expenditures would have to be made to maintain existing energy uses and generating capability at far greater cost to all the people of the State; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of The City of San Diego considers the rejection of the Nuclear Initiative which will be considered by the electorate on June 8, 1976, to be in the best interest of the State of California, and the people thereof.
