

RESOLUTION NO. 216058

MAY 26 1976

WHEREAS, law and order in the City of San Diego depends primarily on the law-abiding behavior of the citizens of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, the decrease in the crime rate in the City of San Diego during the first quarter of 1976 indicates an increase in this law-abiding behavior by the citizens of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, the practice of Transcendental Meditation has been demonstrated to relieve tension, stress, anxiety, and their resultant irrational and antisocial behavior; and

WHEREAS, over 10,000 San Diegans currently practice Transcendental Meditation, which research has shown promotes more orderly behavior and a harmonious influence in the community; and

WHEREAS, evidence indicates that when just one percent of a city's population practices Transcendental Meditation, there is a resultant decrease in the crime rate; and

WHEREAS, Transcendental Meditation is a simple, natural technique which is easily learned by everyone; and

WHEREAS, it would seem that the decreased San Diego crime rate may be attributed in significant measure to the growing practice of Transcendental Meditation by San Diego citizens; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, the week of May 30 through June 5, 1976 be recognized


