

RESOLUTION No. 216347

Adopted on JUN 30 1976

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego as follows: *R 76 - 2670*

That the bids of 1. Norm Pressley's Truck Center, 2. Village Chevrolet, 3. Pearson Ford, 4. International Harvester, and 5. Nixon-Egli Equipment Co. are hereby accepted and the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute contracts for the purchase of 110 pieces of MOTIVE EQUIPMENT as follows:
