RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DECLARING ITS INTENTION TO LEVY AND COLLECT ASSESS-MENTS FOR THE SAN DIEGO STREET LIGHTING MAINTENANCE DISTRICT NO. 1 FOR THE PERIOD JULY 1, 1976 THROUGH JUNE 30, 1977 AND DECLARING ITS INTENTION TO DISSOLVE TWO AREAS FROM SAID DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, in proceedings taken pursuant to the San Diego Maintenance District Procedural Ordinance of 1969 (commencing with Section 65.0201 of the San Diego Municipal Code), this Council heretofore ordered the establishment of the San Diego Street Lighting Maintenance District No. 1 by Resolution No. 203247, adopted July 27, 1971, and ordered the costs and expenses of said maintenance to be assessed to the benefiting property within the assessment district; and

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 11622, New Series, the City Council amended said procedural ordinance and it is now known as the San Diego Maintenance District Procedural Ordinance of 1975; and

WHEREAS, the public interest, convenience and necessity now require that the Council declare its intention to levy and collect assessments within the SAN DIEGO STREET LIGHTING MAINTENANCE DISTRICT NO. 1 for the period July 1, 1976 through June 30, 1977; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the San Diego Maintenance District Procedural

Ordinance of 1975 (Chapter 6, Article V, Division 2 of the San Diego Municipal

Code) the City Engineer has submitted his report relative to the estimated energy

and maintenance costs for Fiscal Year 1977 of the San Diego Street Lighting

Maintenance District No. 1, which report is on file in the office of the

City Clerk as Document No. 755872; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council hereby declares its intention to levy and collect assessments with the San Diego Street Lighting Maintenance District No. 1 for the period July 1, 1976 through June 30, 1977, in accordance

with the above-specified report of the City Engineer, which report contains a full and detailed description of the improvements, the boundaries of the assessment district and the proposed assessments upon assessable lots and parcels of land within the district.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that no new areas are proposed to be annexed to the district established by Resolution No. 210944, adopted July 1, 1974, but that the maps showing the parcels to be assessed shall be amended at the time of the hearing to provide for certain recent lot consolidations and lot splits.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council hereby declares its intention to dissolve two areas from the San Diego Street Lighting Maintenance District No. 1 and dispenses with the report and noticing. The areas to be dissolved are Area 6, Mission Beach No. 2 and Area 51, Mission Beach No. 1. The maps of the district shall be amended at the time of the hearing to provide for the dissolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the proposed maintenance includes the supplying of energy to street lights, replacing lamps and other glassware, and the periodic cleaning and painting of standards.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Council does further propose, in connection with the aforesaid maintenance district proceedings, to enter into a new contract with the San Diego Gas & Electric Company for the furnishing of electrical energy and switching for the period of July 1, 1976 through June 30, 1977. Said contract will make provision for the San Diego Street Lighting Maintenance District No. 1 and the form of said contract is on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 755891.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that notice is hereby given that on JUL 28 1976 in the Council Chambers of the City Administration Building, The Charles C. Dail Concourse, 202 "C" Street, in the City of San Diego, California, is the day,

hour and place for the hearing when any person interested may object to the proposed maintenance for the aforesaid territory, the amount of the assessment, or the awarding of the contract. Failure to make objection at that time shall be deemed to be a waiver of all objections and shall operate as a bar for any claim for damages.

Such protest, if any, must be in writing and must contain a description of the property in which each signer thereof is interested, sufficient to identify the same, and shall be delivered to and filed with the City Clerk at a time no later than the hour set for the hearing. No other protests shall be considered.
