WHEREAS, the California Office of Criminal Justice Planning may consent to review for possible funding the project submitted by The City of San Diego referred to as "Crimes Against Property Control," on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. 755860,
NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

That the City Manager is hereby authorized to submit to the California Office of Criminal Justice Planning on behalf of said City, the application for grant for law enforcement purposes.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that in the event the California Office of Criminal Justice Planning consents to fund the above project from funds made available through the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act, The City of San Diego agrees to accept the grant and designates the City Manager to execute, for and on behalf of said City, the contract for the grant for law enforcement purposes, including any extensions or amendments thereof.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that The City of San Diego agrees to provide the required matching funds to said project, including any extension or amendments thereof.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that grant funds received here-
under shall not be used to supplant ongoing law enforcement
expenditures.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that on or after the effective
date of the grant contract, the City Manager is authorized
to execute a contract for the services of a Research
Assistant/Typist.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Police Department is
authorized to use \$12,500 to meet the cash match requirements
of this grant which is budgeted in the Police Department's
Fiscal Year 1977 Budget, and is included in the total
third-year project cost of \$250,000
