He suggested that adjustable depth electrical outlet boxes be purchased rather than the single depth setting box. This saves \$213 per year in the cost of installations. |

| Kenneth A. Anderson Poli | ice \$ 30 | Mr. Anderson is a Police Sergeant in the Patrol Bureau. He suggested that ordinance changes be printed for officers as they occur. In addition to extending the time for reprinting code books from five years to ten years, every officer has an up-to-date reference book. This suggestion saves the City \$300 per year in printing costs. |
| Gordon B. Russell Transpo | ortation \$ 10 | Mr. RXssell is an Electronic Technician in the Communications and Electrical Division. He suggested an easy method of checking the paging circuit of pageboys. Equipment was purchased to dothis job, but Mr. Russell's method was used as an interim measure while waiting for equipment to arrive. |
| Paul L. Newman Park & Re | ecreation \$ 10 | Mr. Newman is a Lifeguard II in the Aquatics Division. He suggested that a sliding arm and runner device be installed on equipment boxes of lifeguard jeeps to prevent box lids from slamming shut The implementation of this suggestion eliminates the danger of possible arm, hand, and head injurie |
| Mary C. Bartlett Employee | Services \$ 10 | Ms. Bartlett is a Junior Typist in the Claims Recovery Program. She suggested that copies of recovery invoices be kept in Employee Services. This suggestion eliminates several trips per week to the Cashier's Office and saves the City an estimated \$80 per year. |
| | Services \$ 10 WITT, City Attorney | Mr. Clements is an Equipment Mechanic in the Equipment Division. He suggested that lifting handles be installed on the rear cover panels of Garwood packers. One year ago Mr. Clements was awarded \$30 for his suggestion. A twelve month review showed a total savings of \$390, and another \$10 award is warranted. |
