WHEREAS, the Palo Verde Irrigation District, The

Metropolitan Water District of Southern California, the

Coachella Valley County Water District, the Imperial Irrigation

District, The City of San Diego, the County of San Diego, and

the City of Los Angeles entered into an agreement under date

of August 18, 1931, herein referred to as the "Seven Party

Water Agreement," fixing their respective priorities in waters

of the Colorado River available for use in California; and

WHEREAS, each of the parties to the Seven Party Water
Agreement holds a water delivery contract with the United States
pursuant to the Boulder Canyon Project Act dated December 21,
1928, 45 Stat. 1057, except the City of Los Angeles and County
of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, it is contemplated that proceedings conforming with the California Environmental Quality Act will be promptly

initiated by the appropriate agencies and Edison for the proper preparation, circulation and consideration of a draft and final Environmental Impact Report with respect to the terms and conditions of said agreement; and

WHEREAS, a Special Environmental Assessment has been prepared by Edison outlining in detail the environmental effects which may result from the actions contemplated by said agreement, a copy of which has been filed in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 756376; and

WHEREAS, such Special Environmental Assessment has been comprehensively examined and considered by this City Council before entertaining this resolution; and

WHEREAS, it is understood that this City Council will confirm or withdraw its approval of the terms of said agreement after a final Environmental Impact Report has been submitted to it for examination; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

(1) That The City of San Diego hereby approves the agreement entitled "Agreement Relating to the Delivery of Water from the Colorado River Aqueduct for Southern California Edison Company's Proposed Nuclear Powerplant Outside of the Coastal Plain of Southern California"; said approval to be confirmed or withdrawn by resolution of The City of San Diego within 30 days after a final Environmental Impact Report has been submitted to said City for examination; and

(2) That upon such confirmation the City Manager be and is hereby authorized, empowered and directed, for and on behalf of said City, to execute and deliver the agreement in the form of Document No. 756375
