SUBJECT: Taxicabs - Certificates of Convenience and Necessity

BACKGROUND

Regulation of certificate issuance and taxicab service is in the interest of providing the citizens of San Diego with a local transportation service of good quality. Toward attainment of that goal, the City finds it desireable to regulate taxicab certificate issuance and to set minimum levels of service.

PURPOSE

To establish a policy with guidelines for the issuance of taxicab certificates of public convenience and necessity which includes a consideration of levels of taxicab service to the public.

POLICY

It is the policy of the City Council that it will consider the issuance of additional taxicab certificates of public convenience and necessity to existing certificate holders on a request basis. The City Manager will conduct an investigation when the population of the City of San Diego has increased to 750,000, as determined by the official United States census or the official California State Department of Finance population estimate, to determine whether hearings should be held on the issuance of additional certificates. Thereafter, hearings will be held by the City Council on the issuance of additional certificates when the population of the City of San Diego increases by 50,000 people, as determined by said indices.

If the Council, after public hearings, as provided for by Section 72.0101 of the San Diego Municipal Code, determines that the public convenience and necessity require additional taxicabs, the Council shall issue certificates therefor; however, the total number of additional certificates shall in no case exceed one for 10,000 inhabitants over and above the 700,000 population.

The Council experessly reserves the right to depart from the foregoing stated policy when, in the opinion of the Council, the public convenience and necessity require.

IMPLEMENTING PROCEDURE

The following procedure is to be observed in the issuance of additional taxicab certificates, as directed by the above policy:

- 1. Cab Company requests additional certificates.
- Upon receipt of request, the City Manager would investigate and review the key operating statistics, including certificate utilization ratios, levels of service, and other information as required by the Municipal Code.
