WHEREAS, The City of San Diego recognizes the importance of maintaining the technical proficiency of its staff; and

WHEREAS, until recently the multidisciplinary approach to problems of transportation was not taught in undergraduate or even in graduate schools; and

WHEREAS, an intensive six-week program in urban transportation for training professionals concerned with various aspects of transportation has been developed by the Transportation Research Institute of Carnegie-Mellon University; and

WHEREAS, the Urban Mass Transportation Administration, U.S. Department of Transportation, has evaluated the Carnegie-Mellon Professional Program in Urban Transportation and finds it appropriate for fellowship support; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the City Manager be and he is hereby authorized to submit for and on behalf of said City an application for financial assistance to the U. S. Department of Transportation for the purpose of obtaining a fellowship for a representative from the Planning Department to attend the Carnegie-Mellon University Professional Program in Urban Transportation in accordance with Document No. 756383 on file in the office of the City Clerk.

2. That if the fellowship is approved by the U. S. Department of Transportation, the City Manager be, and he is hereby authorized to execute the required agreements, and make whatever additional applications or arrangements that may be required.

3. That the City Manager be, and he is hereby authorized to transfer the sum of \$5,637 from the unallocated reserve to the Planning Department (12.00) Object Account Number 3213 (Scheduled Travel), until the City is reimbursed by the grant.
