BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the City Manager be and he is hereby authorized to submit for and on behalf of said City an application for financial assistance to the U. S. Department of Transportation for the purpose of obtaining a fellowship for a representative from the Planning Department to attend the Carnegie-Mellon University Professional Program in Urban Transportation in accordance with Document No. 756383 on file in the office of the City Clerk.

- 2. That if the fellowship is approved by the U. S. Department of Transportation, the City Manager be, and he is hereby authorized to execute the required agreements, and make whatever additional applications or arrangements that may be required.
- 3. That the City Manager be, and he is hereby authorized to transfer the sum of \$5,637 from the unallocated reserve to the Planning Department (12.00) Object Account Number 3213 (Scheduled Travel), until the City is reimbursed by the grant.
