WHEREAS, the Public Works Employment Act of 1976 provides for federal financial assistance to be utilized in a nationwide construction renovation, repair or other improvement of local public works projects which will provide employment opportunities and the construction of useful public facilities; and

WHEREAS, The City of San Diego is an eligible applicant to share with other governmental entities in such financial assistance; and

WHEREAS, a prerequisite to the processing of an application by the Economic Development Agency, the federal agency administering the Public Works Employment Act of 1976, is that on-site labor can begin within ninety (90) days of project approval by federal authorities; and

WHEREAS, time is of the essence to complete processing of the application for these capital improvement projects because of the 90-day on-site labor requirement; NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

That the City Manager be and he is hereby authorized and empowered to submit, for and on behalf of said City, grant applications for projects as approved by the City Council in a special meeting on September 14, 1976, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof,

including appropriate certifications and assurances, with the Economic Development Administration (EDA), U. S. Department of Commerce for financial assistance under Title I of the Public Works Employment Act of 1976 and to transcribe the contents of the applications and supportive certifications and assurances onto applicable forms as prescribed and directed by EDA at such time as said forms are made available to The City of San Diego by EDA and upon approval by EDA, authorizing the City Manager to execute said grant applications.
