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SEP 14 1976

WHEREAS, the Public Works Employment Act of 1976 provides for federal financial assistance to be utilized in a nationwide construction renovation, repair or other improvement of local public works projects which will provide employment opportunities and the construction of useful public facilities; and

WHEREAS, The City of San Diego is an eligible applicant to share with other governmental entities in such financial assistance; and

WHEREAS, a prerequisite to the processing of an application by the Economic Development Agency, the federal agency administering the Public Works Employment Act of 1976, is that on-site labor can begin within ninety (90) days of project approval by federal authorities; and

WHEREAS, present practice for the advertising of bids for capital improvement construction projects requires Council action for a resolution authorizing advertising for bids whenever a project is undertaken; and

WHEREAS, time is of the essence to complete processing of the application for these capital improvement projects, because of the 90-day on-site labor requirement; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That the Purchasing Agent of The City of San Diego be and he is hereby authorized and directed to proceed to publish in accordance with law, notice to contractors calling for bids for all public works of improvement approved for financing by the Economic Development Agency pursuant to the Public Works Employment Act of 1976 provided that plans and specifications for the furnishing of all labor, material, tools, equipment, transportation and other expense necessary or incidental for said approved public works of improvement shall be filed in the Office of the City Clerk of The City of San Diego, California, prior to any publishing being made hereunder.
- 2. That by Resolution No. 215808, adopted April 21, 1976, this Council ascertained the current or prevailing rate of per diem wages paid by private employers in the City for each craft or type of workman or mechanic needed to execute the contract, and does hereby declare that the wage scale included in said resolution is the said current or prevailing rate for the various crafts that will be applicable to projects approved and constructed pursuant to the Public Works Employment Act of 1976.
