WHEREAS, United Nations Week will take place October 24 through October 30, 1976; and

WHEREAS, the United Nations and its activities have been and can again serve vital interests of our own and other nations; and

WHEREAS, both major American political parties have expressed support of the ideals underlying creation of the United Nations; and

WHEREAS, it still holds the promise of the best international organization for promoting the peace of the world; and

WHEREAS, however, those ideals and goals have been gravely subverted by irresponsible conduct of the UN General Assembly; and

WHEREAS, such conduct achieved such a depth in the adoption by the General Assembly of the cynical and utterly immoral racist resolution condemning Zionism as racism that it discredits the underlying goals and principles of the UN, threatens to deprive the UN of all moral authority and, therefore, gravely jeopardizes the hope that the UN can achieve the goal of its founders as the forum for the preservation of peace and understanding; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

That October 24 through October 30, 1976, be recognized as United Nations Week, but that the people of San Diego be urged to take part in its observance by expressing their hope for a marked change in conduct of the affairs of the General Assembly reflecting honest cooperation for peace and the clear understanding that such marked change is a necessary condition to their continued support--not of the original principles and goals of the UN but--of the present body as a fit or realistic agency for achieving those goals.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Mayor Pete Wilson be designated the City's official representative to the opening day ceremonies in Balboa Park and to other United Nations Week events for the purpose of presenting this resolution.
