

RESOLUTION NO. 216900

WHEREAS, the Suggestion Awards Committee has heretofore made certain recommendations to this Council; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed said recommendations as well as the suggestions as presented; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

That the following suggestion awards are hereby approved and the Auditor and Comptroller is hereby directed to issue warrants out of the General Fund for the following suggestions:

Barbara J. Warren Neil E. Tucker Alvin W. Broyles	Utilities	\$480	Barbara Warren is an Intermediate Typist in the Communications and Electrical Division, and Neil Tucker and Alvin Broyles are Utility Supervisors in the Water Delivery Systems section of the Utilities Department. They suggested that a fee be charged and deducted from the refund due a consumer to recover the actual costs to the City incurred as a result of new installations and connections. Although this is no longer being done, \$4,828 was actually saved during the period of the suggestion use.
Glen A. Paulen	General Services	\$440	Glen Paulen is a Welder in the Equipment Division. Glen suggested that Landfill Dozer blades be rebuilt rather than buying new blades. This is currently being done for an estimated annual savings of \$4,425.
Tom Hernandez, Sr.,	General Services	\$235	Tom Hernandez is a Plumber Supervisor in the Buildings Division. Tom suggested that plastic pop up sprinkler heads rather than riser sprinkler heads be used in City parks. This suggestion will save an estimated \$4,644 in the first year in labor and material costs. This is a partial award pending a final 12-month review.
Lester D. Riemer	General Services	\$175	Lester Riemer is an Equipment Operator III in the Solid Waste Division. Lester suggested that the two ripper shanks on a landfill dozer be modified so that the equipment can pull material out of tight areas where there is insufficient room to get the dozer behind the material to be moved. Not only does this save the City \$1,753, but it also improves the safety of such an operation.
Neil E. Tucker	Utilities	\$150	Neil Tucker is a Utilities Suprvr. in the Water Delivery Systems section. Neil suggested that steel cylinders be used in shoring for the installation and repair of deep sewer laterals, mains, and manholes. This method replaces the timber shoring method and saves the City an estimated \$3,140 a year. This is a partial award pending a final 12-month review.
