NAME	DEPARTMENT	AMOUNT	SUCCESTION
Laurie S. Lindeneau	u Planning -:	\$90	Laurie Lindeneau is an Assistant Planner. She suggested a method for reducing the storage area and the time required to process job control language card decks in Planning computer analyses. This has saved the City \$897 in the first year of operation.
Edward J. Zitter	Police	\$50	Edward Zitter is a Sergeant in the Traffic Operations program. He suggested a new procedure for the routing of citizen complaints. This not only is expected to cut complaint response time, but it also is expected save \$1,154 per year in personnel time. This is a partial award pending final 12-month review.
Danny L. Lenz	General Service	s \$45	Danny Lenz is a Painter in the Buildings Division. Danny suggested that Recreation Facility Caretakers be supplied with the cleaning agent to remove graffitifrom restroom stalls. This saves approximately \$443 per year in travel time required for the painters to do the job.
Robert V. Murphy	Park & Recreation	\$25	Robert Murphy is a Utility Supervisor in the Park Division. He suggested that a power sweeper be used to remove sand from ocean parks after storms. It is estimated thatthis will save \$250 per year in personnel time.
Russell S. Giles	Police	\$20	Russell Giles is a retired Police Sergeant. He suggested that the police vehicle public address system be adapted for use in the "Kids and Skids" program. His suggestion improves the quality of the presentation, and it is felt a \$20 award is merited.
David R. Hughey Francis L. Clemings	Park & Recreation	\$20	David Hughey and Francis Clemings are Utility Workers I in the Community Services Division. They suggested that extra net loops be welded on basketball rims to prevent repairing so frequently. It is difficult to estimate the savings of this suggestion, and this represents a partial award pending a final 12-month review.
